Terminated the Anti-dumping investigation concerning Solar cells from China, Thailand And Vietnam

On November 09, 2022, Directorate General of Trade Remedies within Department of Commerce issued a notice of termination of anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of Solar Cell originating in or exported from China, Thailand and Vietnam.

Terminated the Anti-dumping investigation against Solar cells whether or not assembled into Modules or Panels, classified under HS Codes 8541.40.11 and 8541.10.12.

Reason for termination: Domestic Industry of India submitted a withdrawal application dated July 14, 2022. The withdrawal application was circulated and was supported by interested parties. Thus, the Authority issues a public notice, terminates an investigation upon a request from the domestic industry.



Extended the deadline to issue preliminary and final determination in Circumvention inquiry on certain Crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells from Cambodia, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam

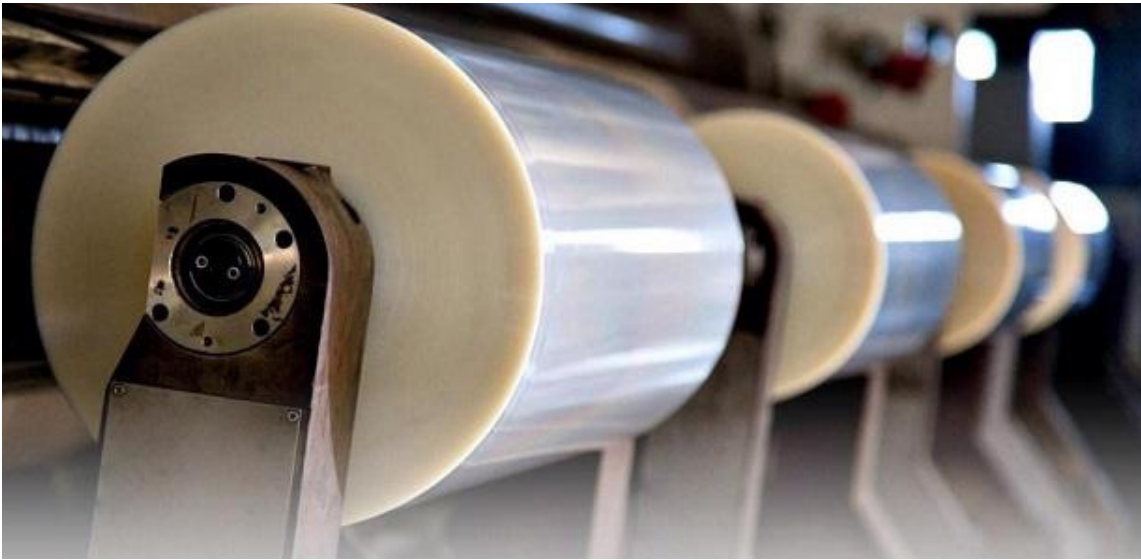
On November 14, 2022, DOC issued an extension of the deadline to issue the preliminary and final determination in circumvention inquiry on anti-dumping and countervailing duties on certain crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells, whether or not assembled into modules from Cambodia, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam, as follows:

1. The deadline to issue preliminary determination: until December 01, 2022.

Reason for extension: Interested parties have submitted comments concerning the upcoming preliminary determination, in addition, these inquiries pose numerous complex methodological issues for which DOC requires more time to consider fully and analyze.

2. The deadline to issue final determination: on May 01, 2023.

Reason for extension: DOC found that the inquiry is extraordinarily complicated, an additional amount of time that is commensurate with the length of the extension of the preliminary determination. Thus, DOC has determined that good cause exists to extend the deadline.



MOIT issued a decision to review new exporters in the case of applying Anti-dumping measures on certain Plastic products and Biaxially oriented polypropylene (BOPP) films, imported into Vietnam (CASE NO. NR01.AD07)

On November 14, 2022, MOIT issued a decision to review new exporters in the case of applying anti-dumping measures on certain Plastic products and Biaxially Oriented Polypropylene (BOPP) films originating from Malaysia, Thailand and China, imported into Vietnam.

1. Subject products: Certain Plastic products and Biaxially Oriented Polypropylene (BOPP) films, classified under HS codes: 3920.20.10 and 3920.20.91.

2. Current AD duty rate: 9.05% - 23.71%

3. Company under review: SRF Industries (Thailand) Limited (SRF Thailand)

4. Review period: October 01, 2021 - end of September 30, 2022

5. Time limit for review: no more than 03 months from the issuance date of the Decision, in necessary cases, it may be extended once but not exceed 03 months.

6. Registration as interested parties: Individuals and organizations can submit an application to participate as interested parties in the review to the Investigation Authority within 60 working days from November 14, 2022 through (i) post office or (ii) electronic mail

The Decision takes effect from November 14, 2022./.
